## Gentlemen:

This is the City of Boston Air Pollution Control Commission's decision on your request for exemption from the requirements of the Parking Freeze for an open-air parking facility located behind 90 Tyler Street, Chinatown, as part of the Chinese Community Service Center, Boston.

Based on Criterion C.4. of the City of Boston Procedures and Criteria for Issuance of Parking Freeze Permits and the information contained in your application, on behalf of the Commission I hereby approve your exemption for a total of eleven (11) parking spaces with the following provisos:

- 1. There shall be no more than eleven (11) vehicles parked in said parking facility at any one time;
- 2. The parking lot shall be restricted to employees, staff, program participants and members ONLY of the Chinese Community Service Center and NOT open to the general public whatsoever;
- 3. All vehicles utilizing said facility shall display a sticker on the rear window stating the Chinese Community Service Center;
- 4. Any changes or modifications from the material submitted with the application in relation to the capacity, ingress/egress, or use, must be submitted and approved by this Commission prior to undertaking such change or modification.
